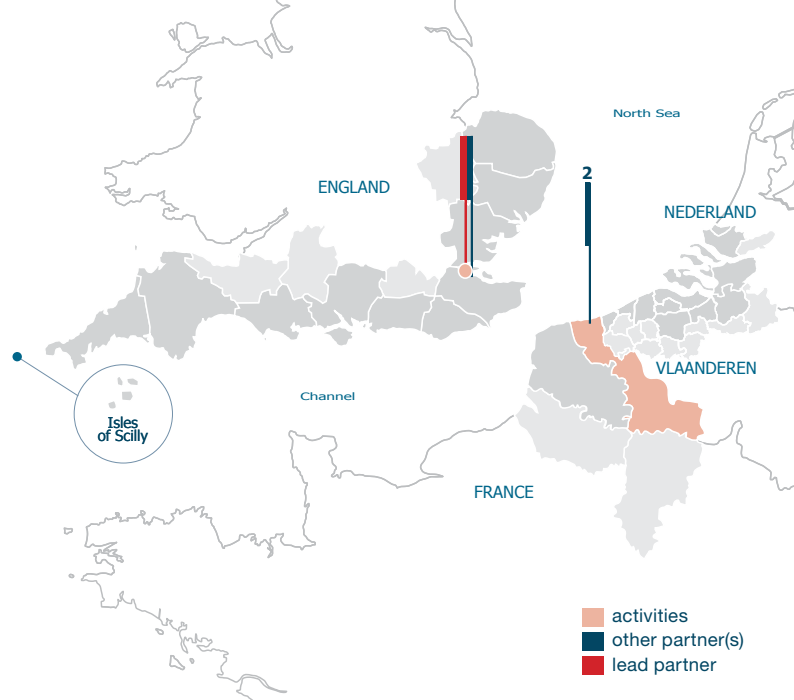


Achieving Community Champions and Enhancing Social Capital for Disadvantaged Communities

The ACCES project's objective is to enhance the quality of life and employability of young people from disadvantaged neighbourhoods in Medway and around Dunkerque.

The partners have seen the great benefits of offering cross-border opportunities and intergenerational exchanges to these communities. The combined experiences of the partners will enable them to address the concerns of the variety of audiences involved.

ACCES will empower these young people by engaging residents and in particular young people in urban regeneration, delivering a crossborder mentoring and parenting skills programme for young parents, and enabling young people to define and develop community projects which improve their neighbourhoods. Partners will also strive to empower young people through crossborder courses in artistic and cultural expression, personal development and sports marshalling, work experience, training and qualifications.
